Orcas Island also has one digital scale for weighing boats, and there's an identical one donated by Chris White that's in the process of being shipped to Victoria which can be used for weighing Vancouver Island boats.

Access to digital weighing scales, one of which is in the process of being shipped (as of June 7) to a location near Royal Victoria Yacht Club for weighing Vancouver Island boats. Orcas Island also has an identical digital scale for weighing boats in Washington State.

Access to Measuring tools which are located in Victoria, Nanaimo, and Orcas Island, and which consist of keel parallels, metric and decimal foot tape measures, contour gauges for keel leading edges, etc. Most Measurers also have Sail Certification Marks on hand for older sails that don't have any applied.

Fleet One Connection - Fleet 2 Members are able to leverage off the Regional Fleet Infrastructure, website, and volunteer base of Fleet One and participate in Fleet One events!

M242 Measurement Certificate Validation

New boat owners please note: Your **M242 Measurement Certificate** must be **re-certified** by the Fleet Measurer (or an Assistant Measurer).



On **Change of ownership**, under the IMCA Constitution (Sections 27, 29, and 30), while an existing Measurement Certificate **may not be invalid**, a new boat owner must have the Certificate reviewed by a Fleet Measurer and **re-certified**.

The Measurer may, at his discretion, re-Measure certain Stations (or re-weigh the boat) to confirm compliance with current Class Rules. The reviewed and/or revised Certificate requires the signatures of the Measurer and new owner along with the date of review.

In the event that a boat does not have a Measurement Certificate, or if the existing one has not been certified per the current **2016 Measurement Certificate** requirements, a new 2016-version Measurement Certificate will need to be issued.











Sail Registry

New boat owners are responsible for filling out and maintaining their own **Sail Registry Form** and filing a digital copy with the local Fleet Measurer. A blank Sail Registry Form can be downloaded off the Fleet website on the upper menu bar by clicking on “M242 Class Docs” and then “M242 Class Sail Registry”.
